Arlington Public Schools - John Larson Stadium Use Rules

Our community and school district have made a significant investment for our students and their programs by constructing an artificial turf field at Arlington High School. In order to maintain the field to provide for years of continued use, the following rules will be strictly enforced for ALL users:

- No food, gum, beverages, tobacco products, seeds, glass, stakes or sharp objects are allowed on the field.
- The only liquid allowed on the field is water. Gatorade and other sport/soft drinks are not allowed on the field.
- Shoes with spikes are prohibited on the field; turf shoes may be used.
- No heat sources with or without flames are allowed on the field.
- No chairs on the field (exceptions may be allowed if provisions are made to protect the turf with tarps).
- No striping or tape allowed on the field.
- No wheeled vehicles motorized or not, are allowed on the track and the field. This includes bicycles, scooters, skateboards, skates. Wheelchairs may be used on the track as appropriate.
- Animals are not allowed in the stadium or on the field, unless it is a certified service animal.
- Parking is prohibited between the stadium and the school. This includes the apron area by the ticket booth.
- Non-District groups wishing to rent the field may be required to pay for a
 District facility monitor to be onsite for the entire event, including setup
 and tear down. Depending upon the event other District staffing may be
 required. All staff charges are for a minimum of two hours. All applications
 for rental will be reviewed to ensure the use is compatible with the facility.
