What's on the Feb. 13, 2024 ballot for Arlington Public Schools?
We're asking the community to consider three measures that work together to support our students, schools, and staff. They are:

- Prop. 1: EP&O levy renewal
- Prop. 2: Capital levy renewal
- Prop. 3: Middle School Bond

School board approves running levies and bond in February election

The Arlington Public Schools board of trustees approved a \$6.54 million levy to support the maintenance and improvement of school facilities and the purchase of new facilities and equipment. The levy will be on the ballot in the February election.

THE FOUR-YEAR EP&O LEVY is a renewal of the levy that has been in place since 2019. It is used to fund the operations of the district, including salaries, benefits, and other personnel expenses. It also funds the district's capital program, which includes the purchase of new facilities and equipment.

THE FOUR-YEAR CAPITAL LEVY is a renewal of the levy that has been in place since 2019. It is used to fund the district's capital program, which includes the purchase of new facilities and equipment.

THE POST MIDDLE SCHOOL BOND is a new bond measure that will be on the ballot in the February election. It is used to fund the construction of new middle schools and the renovation of existing middle schools.
